


Alumni Feedback and Action Taken Report 2020-21


OVERALL FEEDBACK ANALYSIS:

The chart shows the percentage of respondents according to the following Questions:-


1) Do you think Syllabus need Updation?




2) How do you find the course interesting?




3) Was Course Curriculum intellectually stimulated you?




4) How do you find the Course curriculum fulfilling your expectation?




5) Do you think programme has developed your personality?




6) Do you think courses meet the contemporary requirements?
