The feedback from the students guides how to improve the teaching learning process as well as communicate their views and suggestions regarding various parameters related to college and teachers, such as regularity of teachers, coverage of syllabus, use of teaching aids, co-curriculum activities, problem solving mechanism, financial incentives etc. the feedback obtained from 160 students in the year 2019-2020 is analyzed with the help of various tool and techniques. SSS is prepared in a questionnaire form consists of 14 questions into three section and covering almost all the activities of academic and allied activities of the institute. Five-point scale was used to collecting responses of the students as 4 stands for Strongly agree, 3 stands for Agree, 2 stands for Satisfactory, 1 stand for Disagree and 0 stands for Strongly disagree, the rating provided to various parameters is based on their mean scores and categorized as:

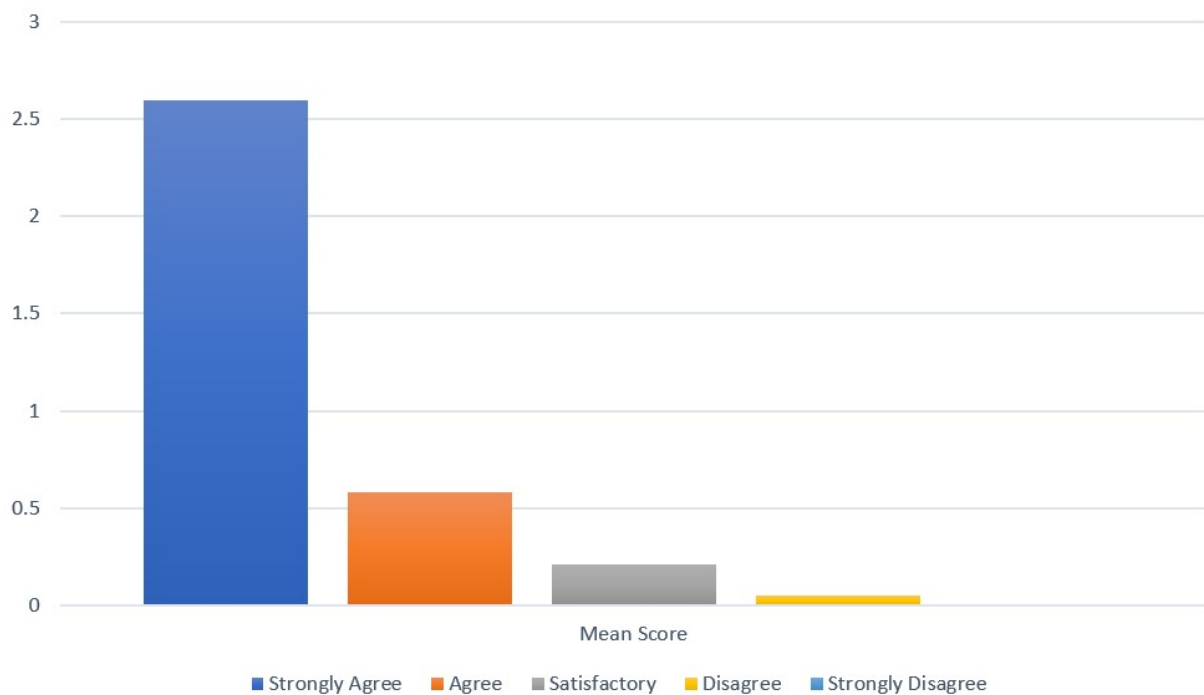
We classified the feedback form into three sections as:

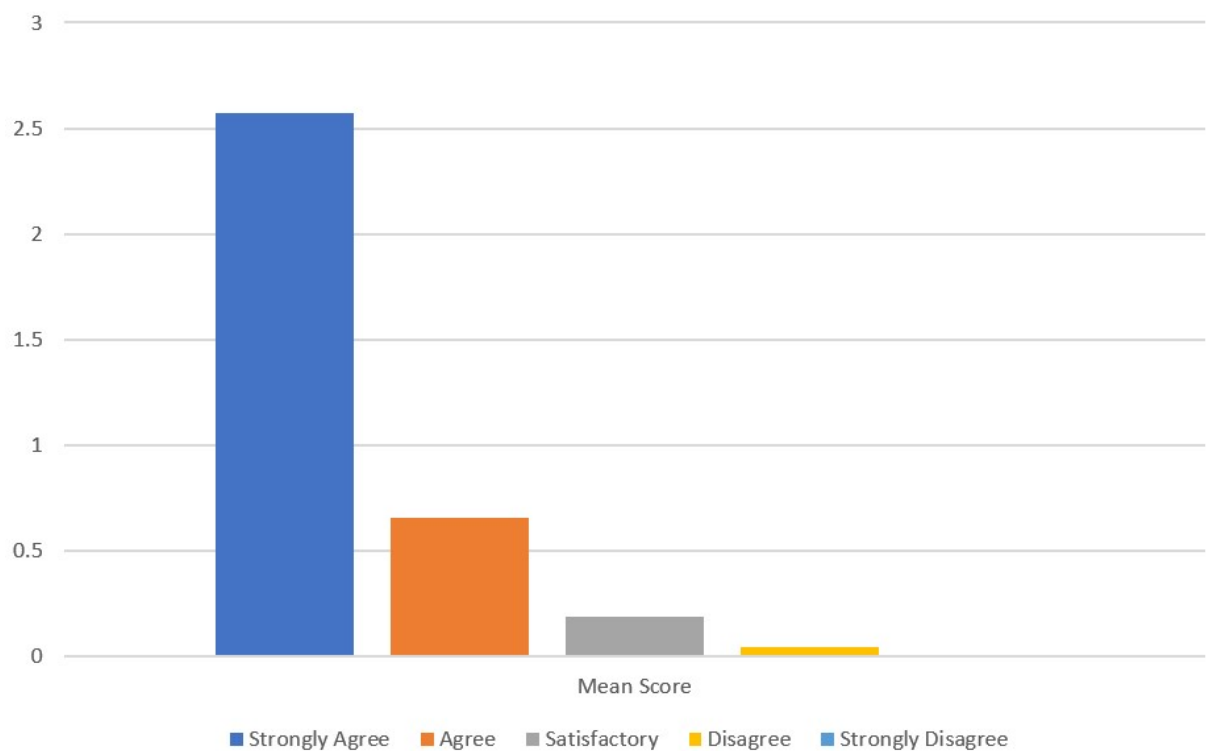

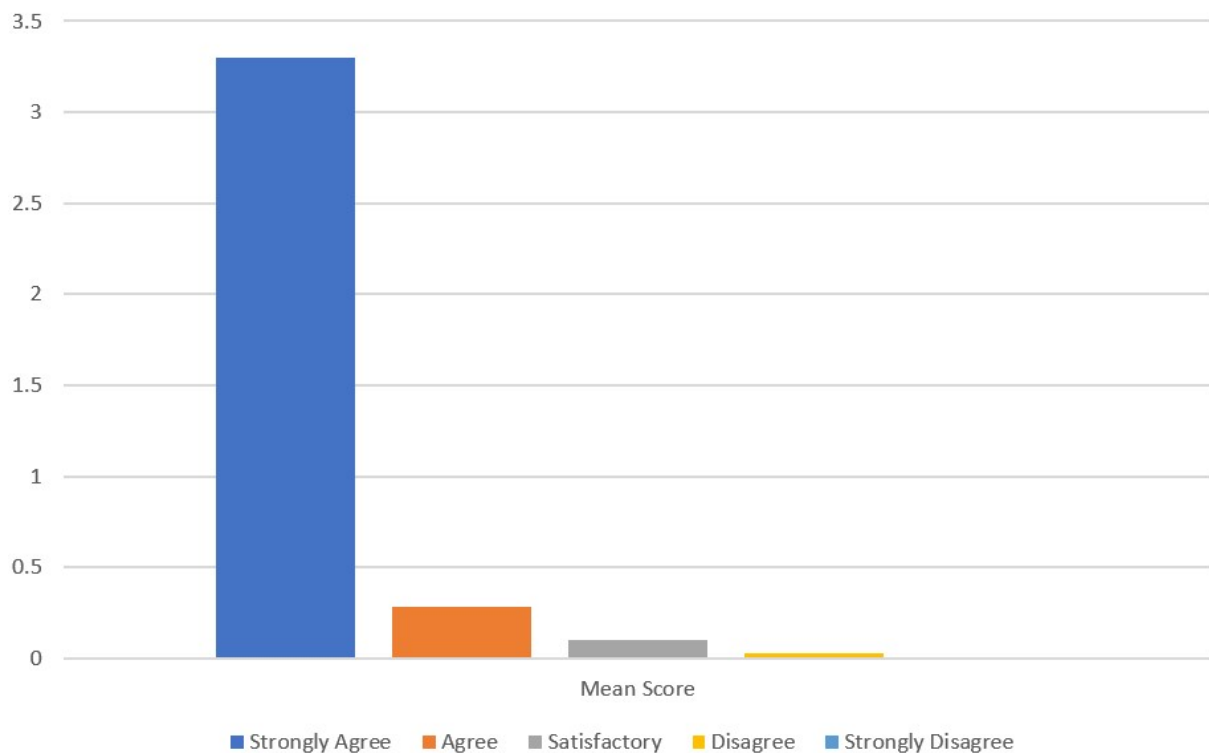

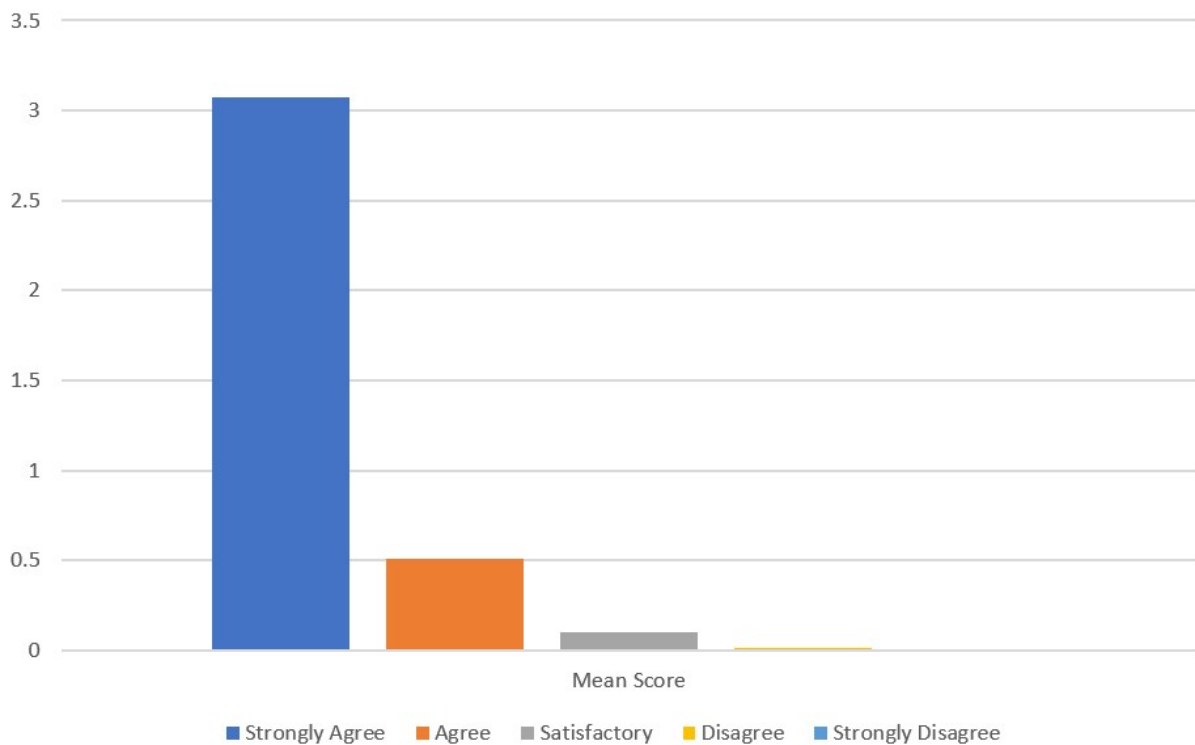
Findings:
