SSS is prepared in a questionnaire form consists of 14 questions into three section and covering almost all the activities of academic and allied activities of the institute. Five-point scale was used to collecting responses of the students as 4 stands for Strongly agree, 3 stands for Agree, 2 stands for Satisfactory, 1 stand for Disagree and 0 stands for Strongly disagree, the rating provided to various parameters is based on their mean scores and categorized as:


We classified the feedback form into three sections as:
















Findings:










