

Analysis Survey of Student Satisfaction Survey 2017-2018

The Feedback from the students guides how to improve the teaching-learning process as well as communicate their views and suggestions regarding various parameters related to college, and teachers, such as regularity of teachers, coverage of syllabus, use of teaching aids, co-curriculum activities, problem-solving mechanism, financial incentives, etc. The feedback obtained from 133 students in the year 2017-2018 is analyzed with the help of various tools and techniques. SSS is prepared in bilingual mode and consists of 14 questions covering almost all the activities of academic and allied activities of the institute. The responses of students were taken on 5 point scale i.e. 0-4. The rating provided to various parameters is based on their mean scores and categorized as:

1. Very good: $(3 \leq \text{M.S.} \leq 4)$
2. Good: $(2 \leq \text{M.S.} \leq 3)$
3. Satisfactory: $(1.5 \leq \text{M.S.} \leq 2)$
4. Unsatisfactory: $(\text{M.S.} < 1.5)$

We classified the feedback form into three sections viz.

- i)* Teaching-learning Process
- ii)* Course Content
- iii)* Evaluation Process.

The framework is as follows:

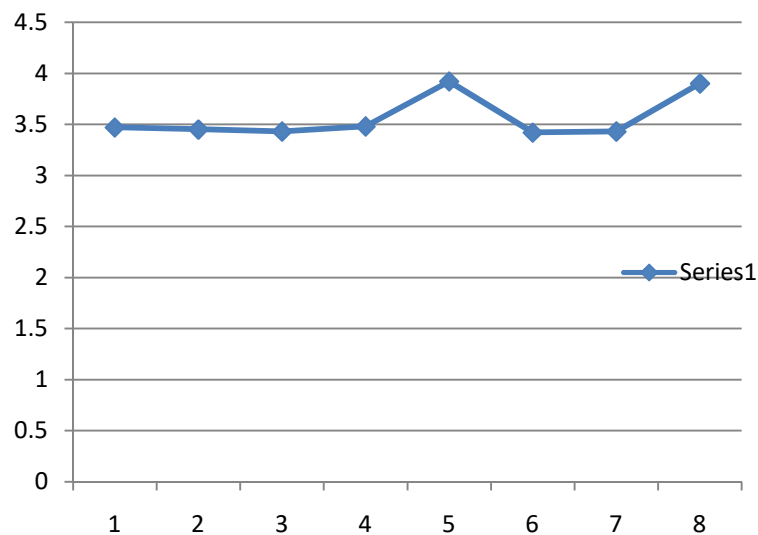

Teaching-Learning Process

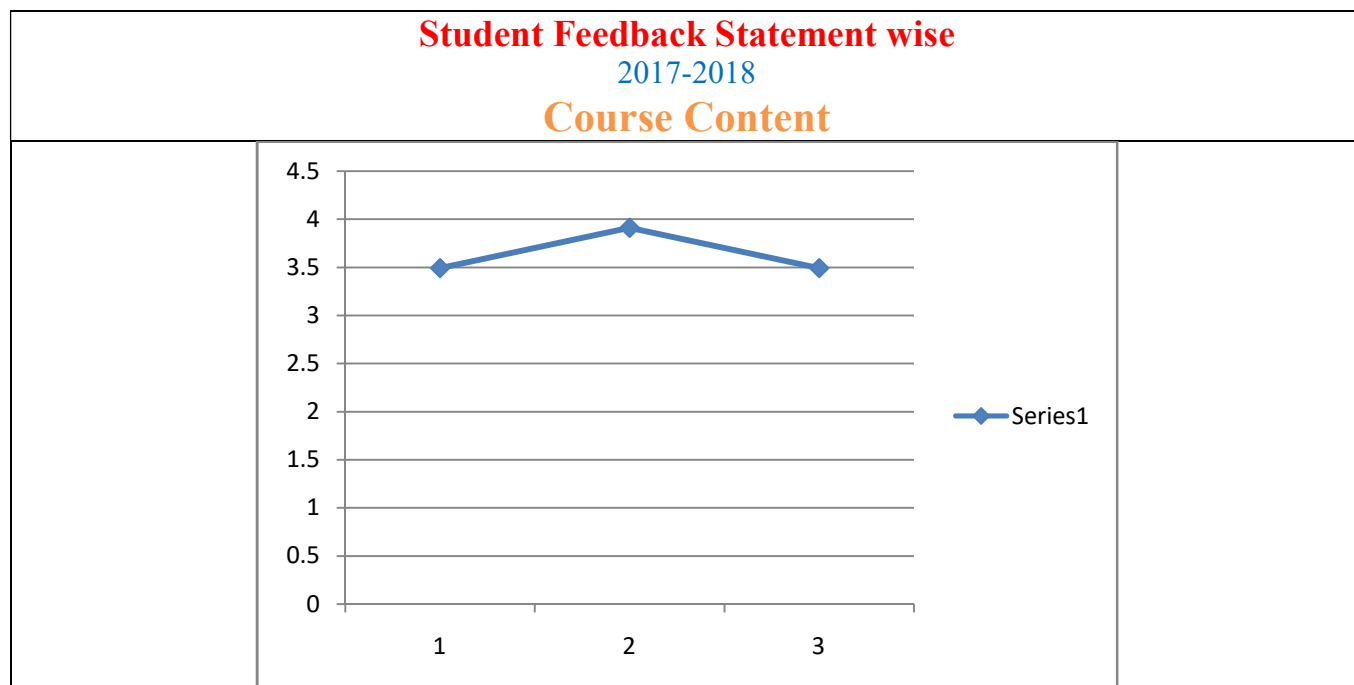


Findings:

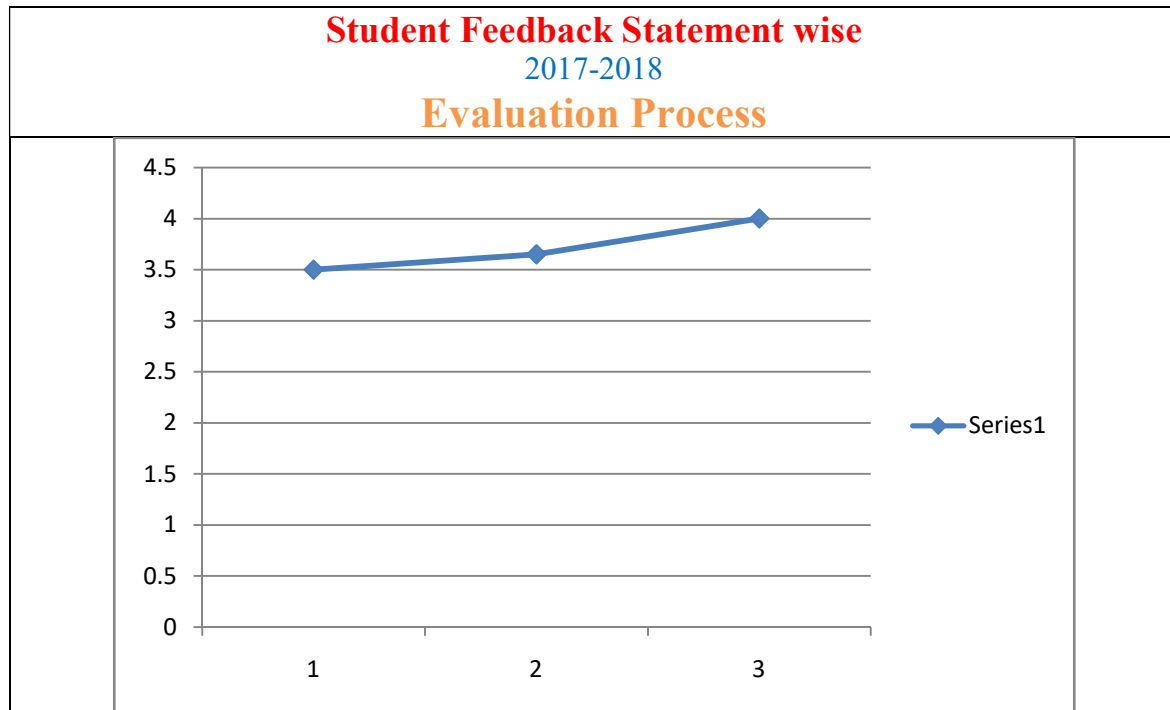


Findings:
